Digitization of Fillmore County newspapers

Libraries are not only places to find the newest titles or experience cutting edge technologies; they are also archives of our history. Digitizing issues of Fillmore County newspapers, dating from 1870, enables them to be posted online and full-text searchable using Optical Character Recognition. This ensures local history becomes freely accessible to all at:

Over \$36,000 is needed to finance this project. The Fillmore County Libraries are asking for your help in reaching this goal. With your help, all county newspapers can be digitized before the 150th anniversary of Fillmore County in the spring of 2021.

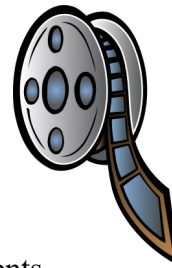
